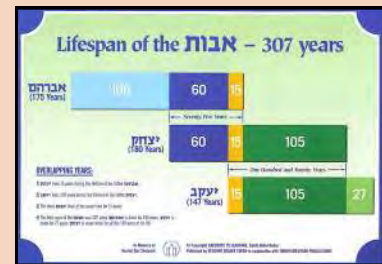

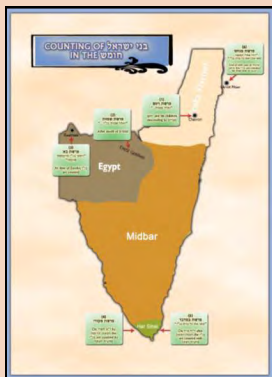

As pointed out in several of the *haskamos* that are printed in the book, the method represents loyalty to the mesorah of teaching Kriah, although it has an up-to-date and eye-pleasing appearance. Intentionally black and white (as opposed to colored pages which, many argue, distracts children, the new sefer has about 450 pages, ushering children from the basics to much more advanced reading - an introduction to Avos and to Tehillim, as well as the 13 Ikrei Emunah.

The last 30 pages comprise the kuntress, "*Umnus Ha'kriah*," which includes instructions in use of the resource as well as fundamentals of lashon hakodesh and teaching it properly.

The new Kriah book was composed *I'ili nishmos* the Sassoon children whose tragic *petirah* has left gaping holes in the collective life of *Klal Yisrael*.
